We tried what the membership requested at the last all-member meeting, but it has not gone well. We'll try an alternative format instead. If that doesn't go well either, we'll just call it off as a good but failed experiment. New rules:

- Standalone courts, no movement between. We'll try separate beginner, intermediate, and advanced courts. If you lose, you go to the back of the line for that court (or a different one if you want to try another level). For example, winning on the beginner court does not mean you move up to the intermediate court. You just stay on the beginner court. This format will eliminate unused courts and move more players in each round.
- Winners stay until you lose, play to 11 and win by 2.

A couple of notes about this. First, some people thought that if you lost on the beginners court, you were just done for the day. That rule did not exist before and will not exist now. Second, do not interrupt open play on the other three courts by moving back and forth between games. Rec games should not be interrupted with replacement players simply so someone doesn't have to stand in line for king's court.
