APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes from the June 2024 Board meeting.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Report was given by Jane Jakubec. We currently have \$22,059.97 in our accounts. HUB insurance bill will be due in a month. Craig Campbell will research insurance coverage for Board members.

MEMBERSHIP REPORT:

Report given by Janice Vaplon. We currently have 192 members signed up for 2024.

GUEST SPEAKER:

Clint Haxton, along with his wife Rita attended the meeting to present to the board his proposed trophy for our September tournament. The trophy is made of red oak, styled in the shape of a pickleball paddle, with an inscription on it as well as a logo. The trophy was well received by the board. Clint was approved to make these trophies for us. We will get him the final number he needs to make closer to the tournament. Clint will be reimbursed \$140 for the cost of materials.

KINGS AND QUEENS COURT:

It was decided to try a new format for Kings and Queens court. One court will be beginner, the second court-intermediate and the third-advanced. Stay at your court unless you want to try another level. If this format doesn't work out, the Kings and Queens court will be dropped.
