ITEMS FROM THE BOARD:

- Phil and Chris Summers would like to speak with the Board to discuss some ideas they have for expanding recreation in Spearfish. They will attend the March Board meeting.
- Phil Bellis told us about information he obtained regarding the use of The Clubhouse of Spearfish for future social events. They have 4 simulators dedicated to golf only and 1 that has other play items such as shooting. Renting the whole facility on a weekday would be \$250/hour for 30-40 people. OR \$40/ hour for 1 simulator, 6-8 people could use that simulator. A food buffet could be provided at an extra charge. They have beer and wine available.
- Another social suggestion is the Brothel in Deadwood. Tours are available. Beer and wine available.
- Jane Jakubec announced that she would be resigning as Treasurer effective the end of June 2026.
- Jim Cooney's position of President is up in June 2026 as well.

- Phil Bellis presented information and ideas regarding the AED need at the courts. Timed running to the current AED in the park, took 1-2 minutes. Suggestion was made to have a session on a Saturday in between the 2 groups playing to teach the use of the AED. Also, CPR training would be good for members to have for playing on the courts. We will discuss this at the April meeting to have the training set up in May. Signs are needed to show location of AEDs.
- Phil also suggested a device that will suck gum or other foreign bodies from the mouth of someone choking.
